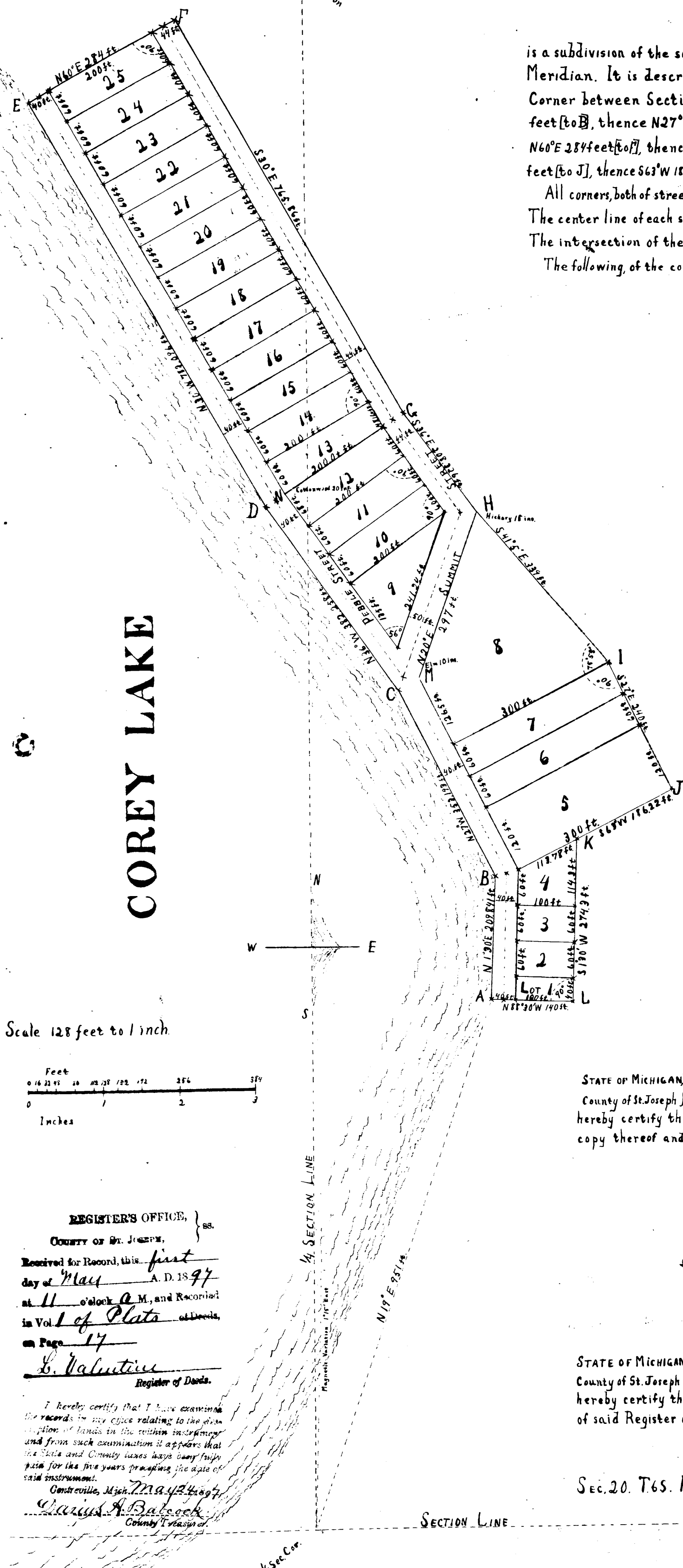


MANOKA PARK



The land embraced in the annexed plat of Manoka Park is a subdivision of the south part of the west fraction of Section 20, Town 6 South of Range 12 West, Michigan Meridian. It is described as follows: commencing at a point (A) (N19°E 951 feet distant from the 1/4 Section Corner between Sections 20 and 29, Town 6 South of Range 12 West, Michigan Meridian); thence N1°30'E 202.041 feet (to B); thence N27°W 353.193 feet (to C); thence N36°W 332.258 feet (to D); thence N30°W 782.096 feet (to E); thence N60°E 284 feet (to F); thence S30°E 765.86 feet (to G); thence S36°E 208.326 feet (to H); thence S41°E 339 feet (to I); thence S27°E 290 feet (to J); thence S63°W 186.22 feet (to K); thence S1°30'W 274.3 feet (to L); thence N17°30'W 140 feet to the place of beginning (A).

All corners, both of streets and lots, are stones marked +; except H, M, and N, which are trees and which are described on the plat. The center line of each street is marked by a stone with a +, at each end of the street, and at each angle except that at C-M. The intersection of the center lines of the two streets, as shown on the plat, is marked by a stone with a +.

The following, of the corners on the plat, are witnessed, as shown below:

- A - Willow 3 ins. S19°W 315 feet, and Willow 3 ins. S10°W 365 feet.
- B - Elm 12 ins. N58°30'E, 47.5 feet.
- C - Elm 10 ins. N58°30'E, 40 feet.
- D - Cottonwood 20 ins. N57°E, 40 feet.
- E - Whiteoak 10 ins. N16°E, 22.5 feet.
- F - Ash 9 ins. S76°W, 22.5 feet.
- G - Ironwood 6 ins. N47°E, 4 feet.
- H - Hickory 3 ins. N53°W, 2 feet, and White Oak 11 ins. S63°W, 17 feet.
- J - Black Oak 5 ins. S25°W, 3 feet.
- K - Black Oak 10 ins. N78°E, 8 feet.
- L - Willow 8 ins. N20°E, 75.5 feet, and Willow 3 ins. S12°30'W, 65 feet.

The area of Manoka Park, including streets, is 11.28 Acres.

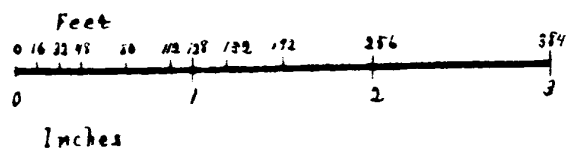

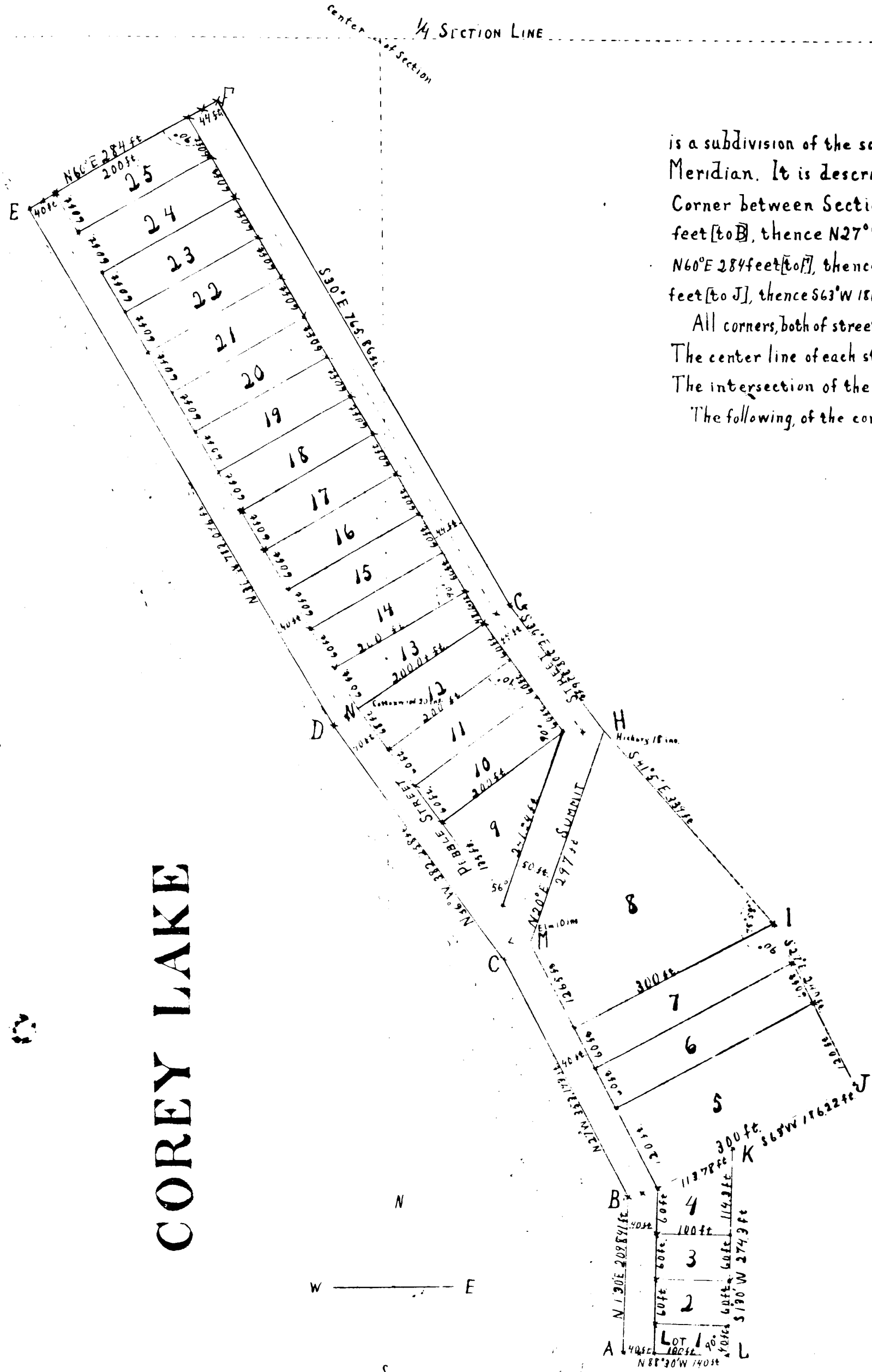

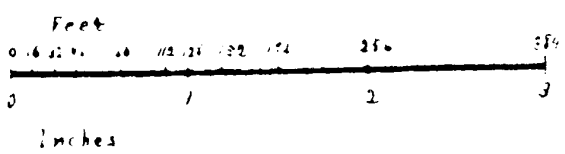
SEC. 20, T6S, R12W.
