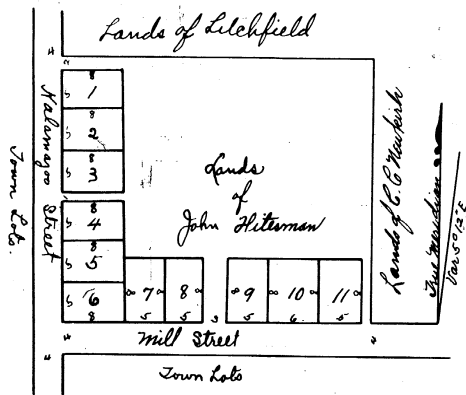


Hitezman's Addition to the Village of White Pigeon
