This is an allotment of that part of the North East fractional quarter of Section 20 Jurin Township 20 Eight South of Range Twelve West. Bounded on the north by lands owned by the Michigan Southern Rail Road Co. on the East by Kalamazoo St on the South by Pine Street and on the West by St Joseph Street in the Village of White Pigeon Also of that part of the North West fractional quarter of Section 20 Linn Town 20 Eight South of Range Eleven West.

South of the center of the Linn road running east & west through said fractional quarter of Sec 20 Corn. The distances on the East side of Kalamazoo Street are given in chains and links reckoning in and from the center of the streets. Those West of Kalamazoo Street are given in feet and inches reckoning from the out lines of the streets. The Red figures denote the number of the lots in which they stand. Kalamazoo Road is eight feet wide All other streets are Sixty Six (66) feet wide.
