Harvey's addition to the Village of Constantine is located upon that part of Section no 24 Township no 7 South of range 12 west described as follows. Beginning at a point in the center of Centreville Street in the Village of Constantine 52 rods East of the west line of said Section. Thence north to the north line of the rail road company's Depot Grounds. Thence west to the East line of Right of Way of said Rail Road. Thence northwardly along said East line of right of way to the Mill pond. Thence Eastwardly and Southwardly along the meandering of said pond to the north and south division line between the East and West halves of the S.W. 1/4 of said Section 24. Thence south on said division line to the center of Centreville Street thence west 28 rods to the Place of beginning.

Centreville Street is 4 rods wide. All other streets are three rods wide. The figure of lots is designated by figures on the Plat
