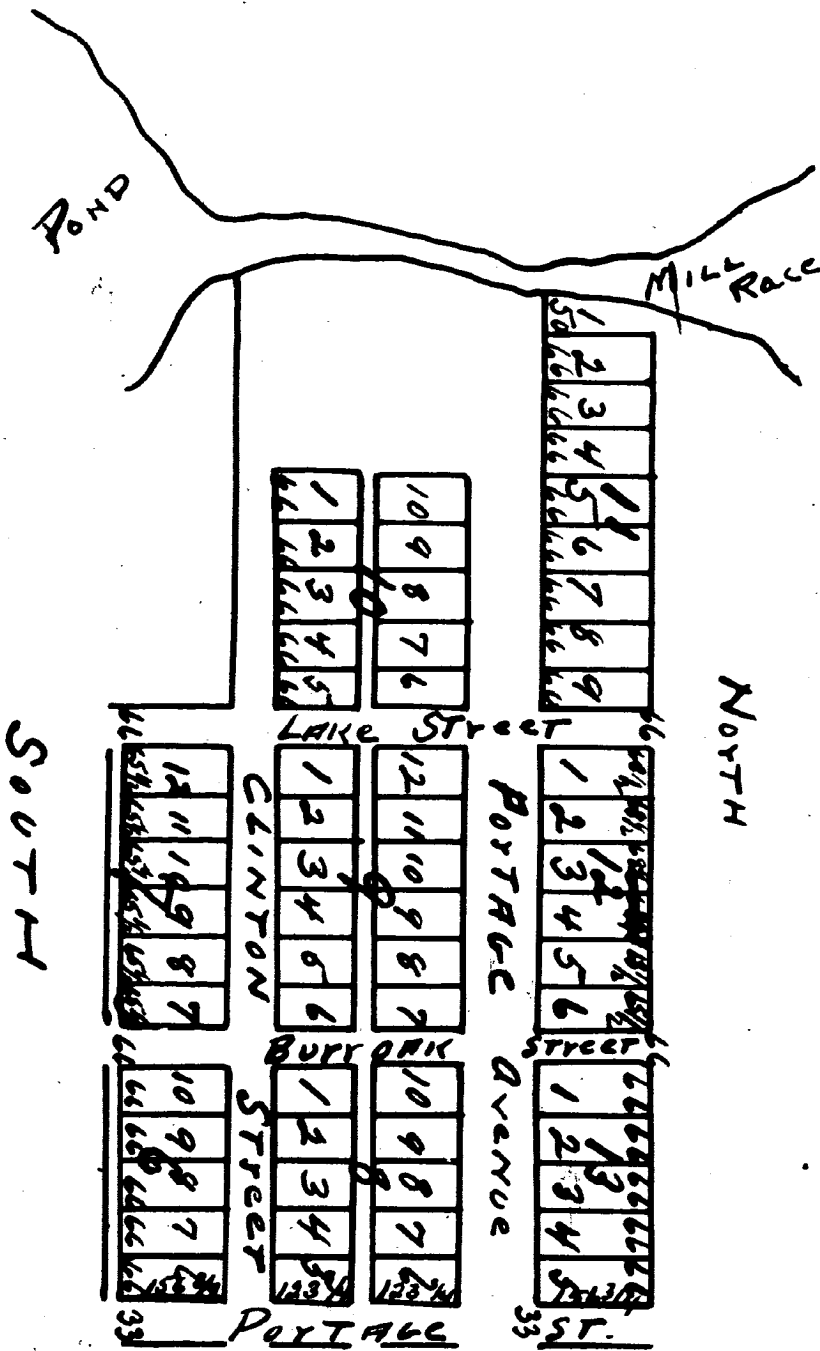


LYMAN'S ADDITION

Survey of Lyman addition to the village of Mendon made June 1st 1868 being located on the north half of section twenty seven in Township five north of Range ten west County of St. Joseph Michigan. The distance in feet is given on each lot. Streets are four rods wide except Postage Avenue which is six rods wide & Postage street which is 33 feet wide. Allys are one rod wide. I certify that the above is correct.
