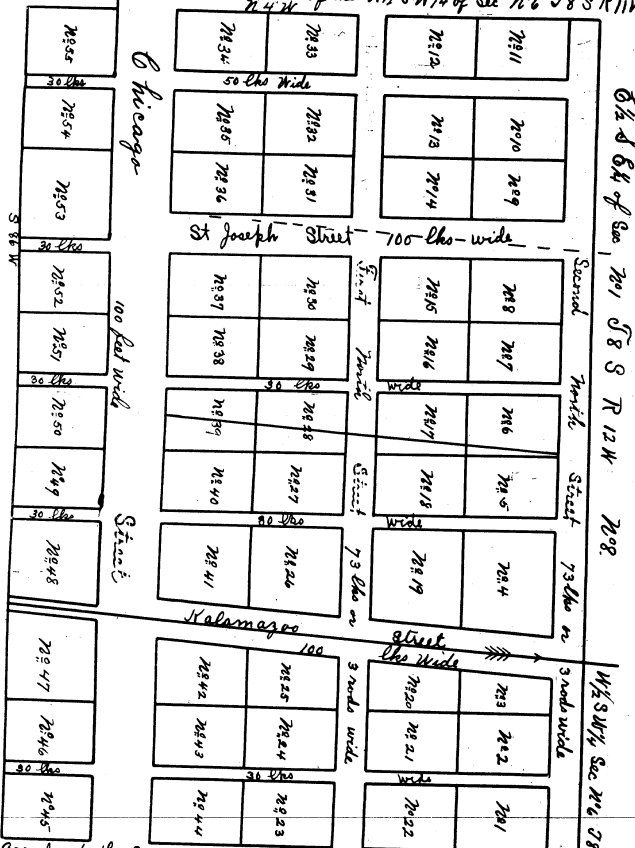


Plat of the Village
