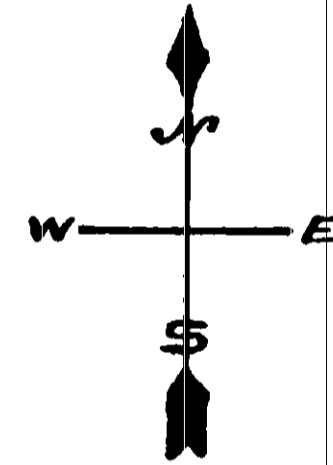

Description

A part of the south west quarter of section number 20, T. 4 S. R. 11 W., being located in St. Joseph County, State of Michigan, and bounded as follows; commencing on the section line 664 feet south of the quarter section corner between sections 19 & 20. Thence south 1325 feet, thence east 627 ft., thence north 1323 ft., thence west 627 ft. to place of beginning; containing 19 1/100 Acre Monuments.

Permanent stone monuments were found planted in the ground as follows, at points E, A & F, each particular point being indicated on the plat by a cross, (+).

- At E a pointed stone.
- " A a stone + d.
- " F a pointed stone.

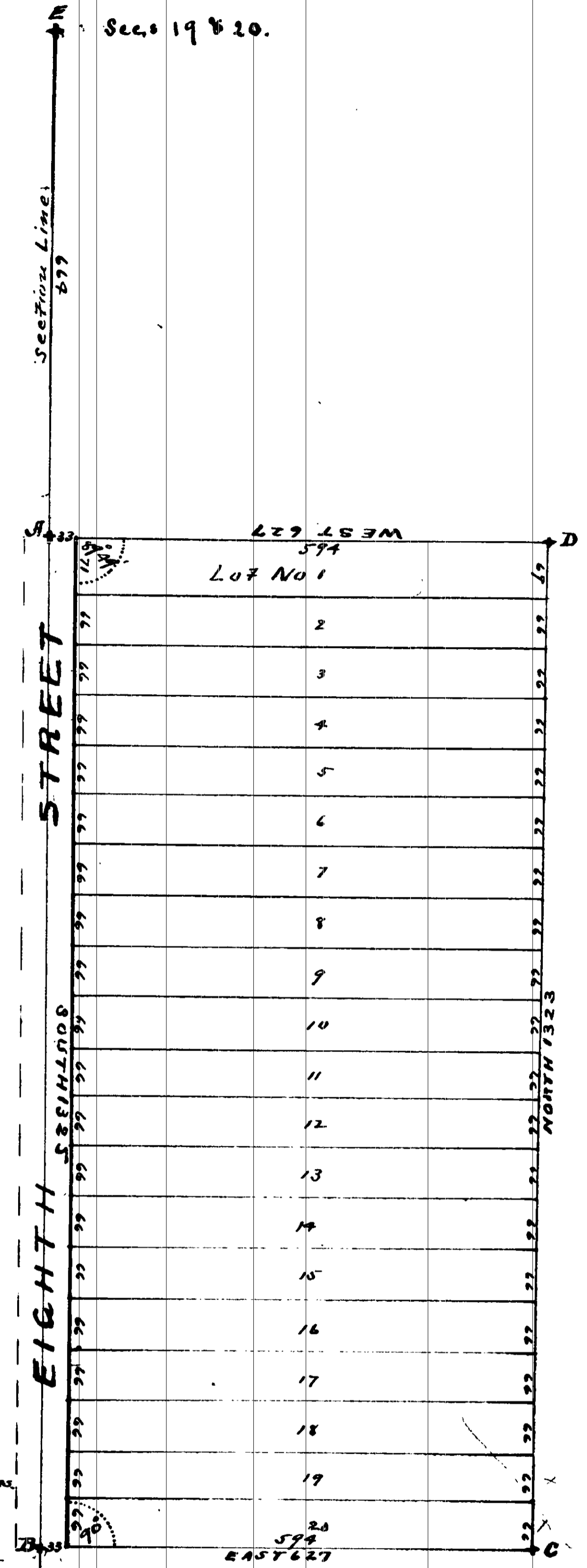
Permanent stone monuments were planted in the ground as follows, at points D, C & D, each particular point being indicated on the plat by a cross, (+).
