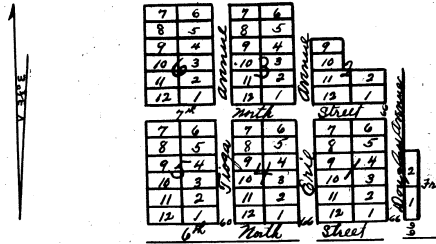


Plat of Cook's Addition

Lots in Blocks 3, 4, 5, 6 East half of Blocks 1 & 2 and the fraction are 66 by 132 feet. Lots in West half of Blocks 1 & 2 are 66 by 148 1/2 feet except Lots 9 & 10 in Block 2 which are 66 by 132 feet.

Know all men by these presents that I John E. Cook of Three Rivers Mich. Proprietor of the accompanying plat entitled "Cook's Addition to the Village of Three Rivers" situated upon a portion of the NW 1/4 of Sec 18 in Town 6 South of Range 11 West in St. Joseph's Mich. and bounded on the South by Arnold's addition to said Village do hereby Give and Grant all the Avenues and Streets laid out in said Plat to the Public for the use of the Public agreeably to the Statute in such case made and provided.
