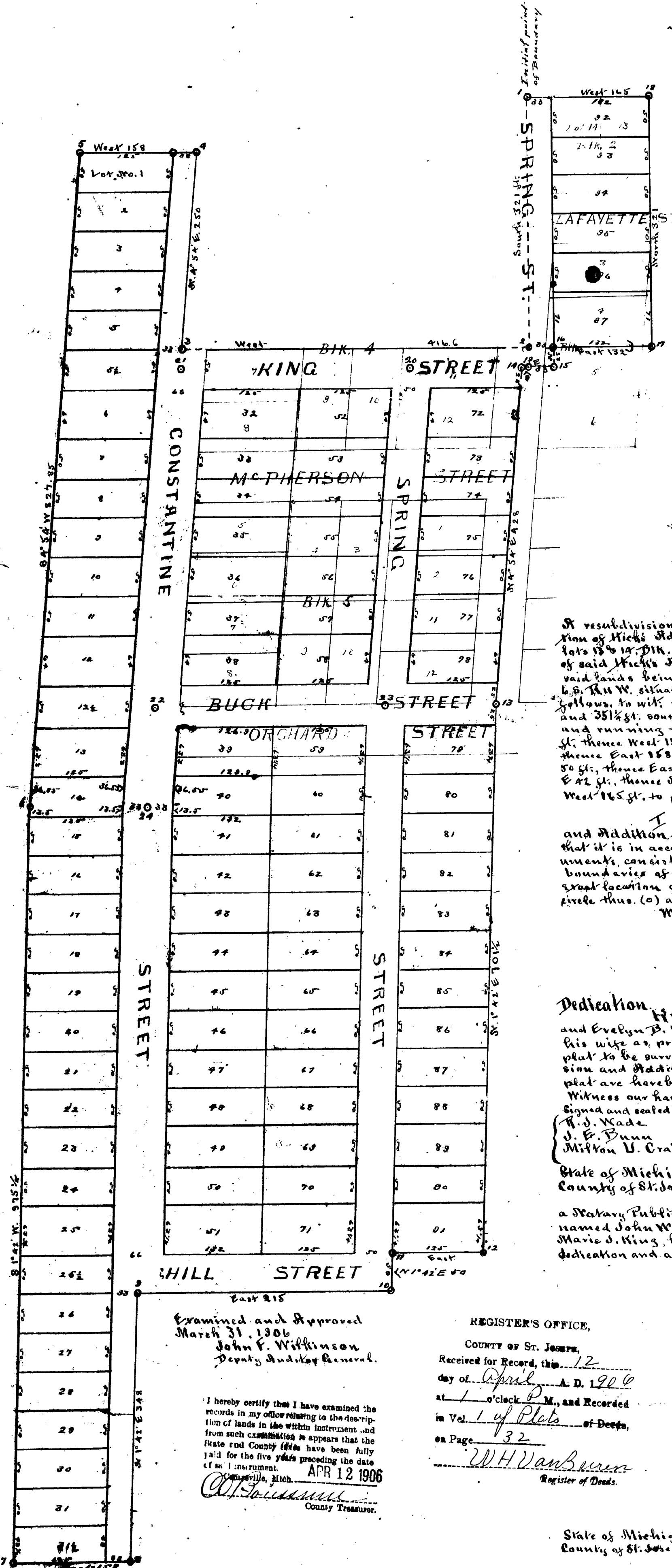
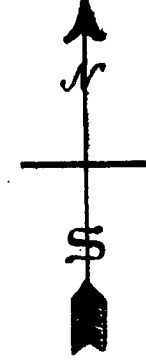


# KING'S RESUBDIVISION AND ADDITION TO THREE RIVERS

**Description**  
A resubdivision of a portion of Mick's Addition to Three Rivers, said portion of Mick's Addition being shown in red on the annexed plat and being lots 18 to 19, Blk. 2, lots 3 & 4 Blk. 3; the South 1/2 of Blk. 4 and all of Block 5 of said Mick's Addition. And a subdivision of adjoining lands, all of said lands being a part of the N. W. fractional quarter of section No. 13, T. 6, S. 34 N. situated in St. Joseph County, State of Michigan, and bounded as follows, to wit: beginning at a gas pipe stake, said stake being 330 ft. west and 35 1/2 ft. south of the quarter section corner between sections 13 and 19 and running thence South 52 1/2 ft.; thence West 416.6 ft.; thence N. 45 1/2 E. 250 ft.; thence West 158 ft.; thence S 45 1/2 W 82 7/8 ft.; thence S 1 1/2 W 375 1/2 ft.; thence East 158 ft.; thence N 1 1/2 E 248 ft.; thence East 215 ft.; thence N 1 1/2 E 50 ft.; thence East 12 1/2 ft.; thence N 1 1/2 E 70 1/2 ft.; thence N 45 1/2 E 428 ft.; thence E 42 ft.; thence North 25 ft.; thence East 132 ft.; thence North 32 1/2 ft.; and thence West 165 ft. to place of beginning.

I have by certifying that I made the survey of King's Resubdivision and Addition to Three Rivers, and that the annexed plat is a correct one and that it is in accordance with the notes of the survey and that permanent monuments, consisting of gas pipe stakes have been set at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted and at the intersection of all streets the exact location of each monument is indicated on the annexed plat by a circle thus (o) and each accompanied by a distinguishing number.
