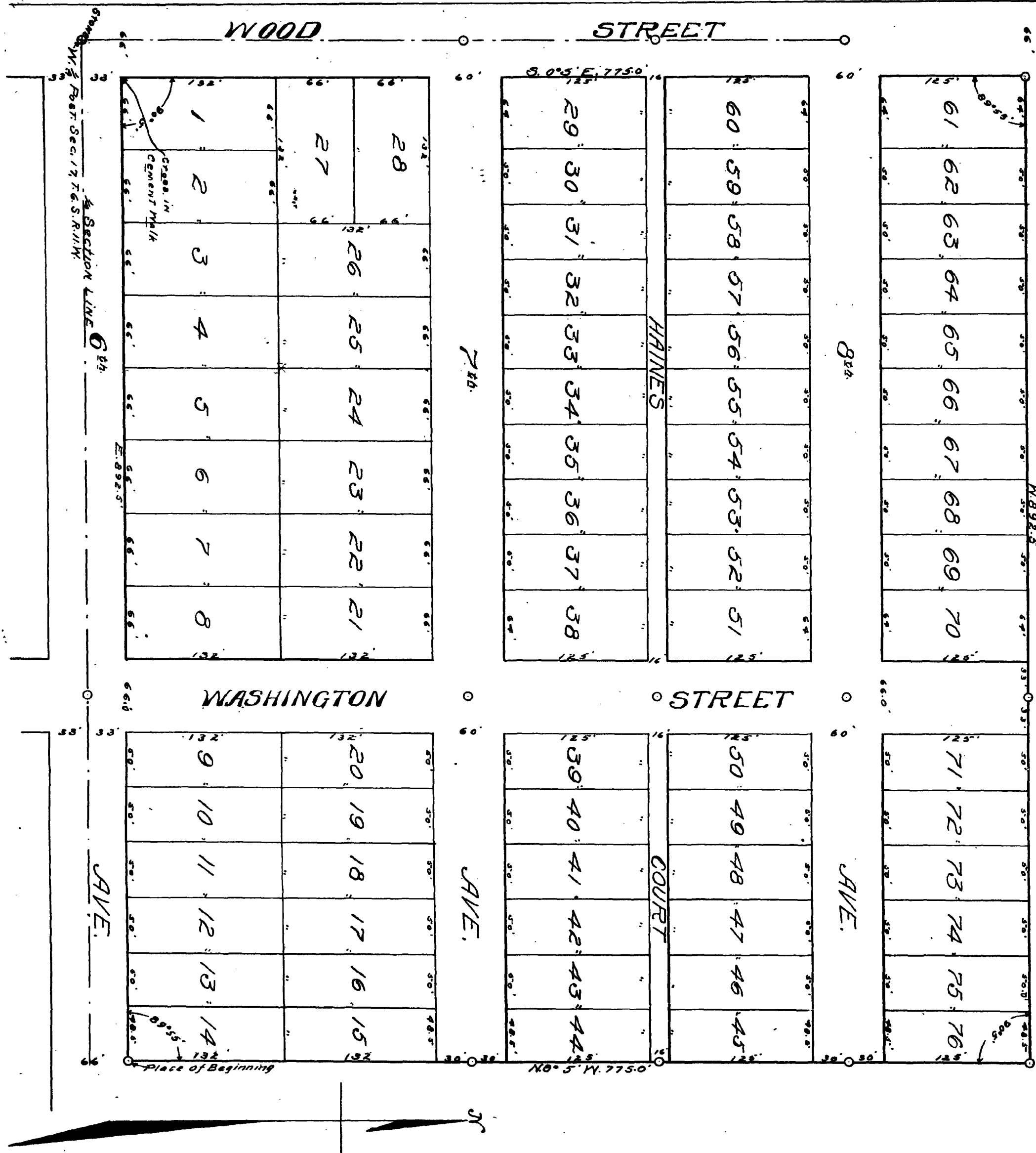


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**PLAT OF

**DESCRIPTION OF LAND  
PLATTED**

All that piece of land lying in the City of Three Rivers, in the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 17, T. 6 S., R. 11 W., more particularly described as follows:  
Beginning at a point 33.0 feet N. and 925.5 feet E. of the W. 1/2 post of Section 17, T. 6 S., R. 11 W., running thence N. 0° 5' W. 775.0, thence W., parallel to the 1/2 Section Line 892.5 feet, thence S. 0° 5' E. 775.0 to the N. E. corner of Wood and 6th Ave., thence E. 892.5 feet to the place of beginning.
