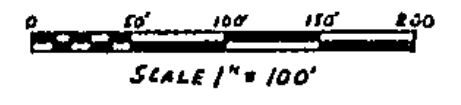
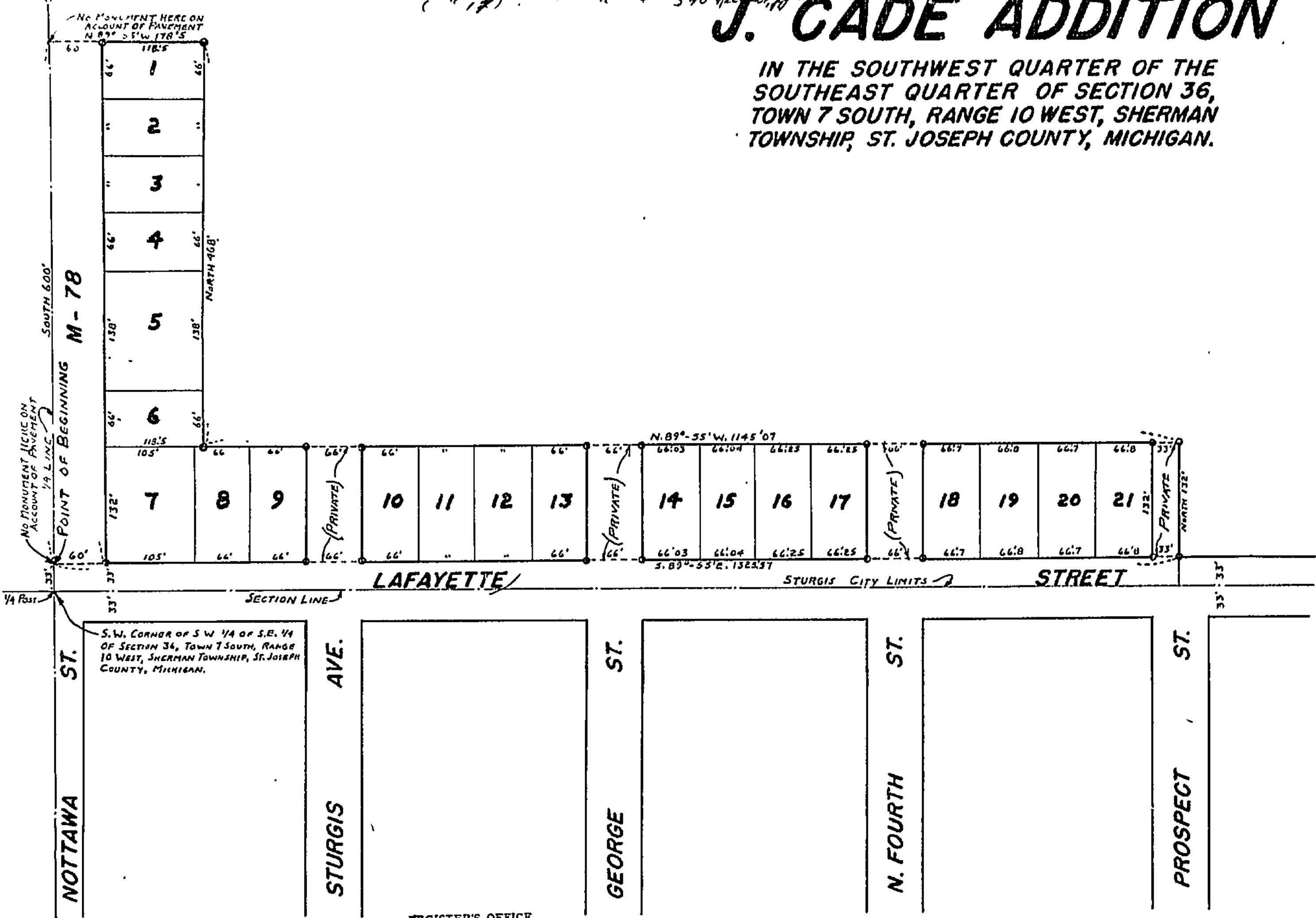


J. CADE ADDITION

THE DESCRIPTION OF J. CADE ADDITION IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 36, TOWN 7 SOUTH, RANGE 10 WEST, SHERMAN TOWNSHIP, ST. JOSEPH COUNTY, MICHIGAN, IS AS FOLLOWS, BEGINNING 33 FEET NORTH OF SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SAID SECTION 36, THENCE SOUTH 84 DEGREES AND 55 MINUTES EAST 1328.57 FEET, THENCE NORTH 132 FEET, THENCE NORTH 89 DEGREES AND 55 MINUTES WEST 1145.07 FEET, THENCE NORTH 468 FEET, THENCE NORTH 89 DEGREES AND 55 MINUTES WEST 1785 FEET, THENCE SOUTH 600 FEET TO BEGINNING.
