

ST. JOSEPH COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION  
MARCH 1, 2021 AT 8:30 A.M. IN COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE

The St. Joseph County Election Commission met at 8:30 a.m. on March 1, 2021. The Commission reviewed the ballot proposals and candidate list for the May 4, 2021 Special Election.

Ballot quantities were approved at 1,400 for Constantine and 1,000 for White Pigeon. The following proposals were placed on the May 4, 2021 Special Election ballot:

Village of White Pigeon

Proposal to Renew Ambulance Services Millage

Shall the previous voted millage increase in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in the Village of White Pigeon of .35 mills (\$0.35 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed at and increased up to the original voted .35 mills. (.35 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied at up to .35 mills for 4 years (2021 through 2024 inclusive) for the purpose of funding the provision of ambulance services in the Village and paid over to LifeCare and/or any other professional ambulance service provider contracted by the Village; and shall the Village levy such increase in millage for said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$11,089?

Village of Constantine

Ordinance to Amend Section 39-40 of the Code of Village Ordinances

Shall the Village of Constantine adopt the attached ordinance completely prohibiting Adult-Use (recreational) marijuana establishments in the village?

Sec. 1 Amendment. Section 39-40 of the Code of Village Ordinances of the Village of Constantine is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 39-40. Adult-Use Marijuana Establishments prohibited.

Marijuana establishments, as that term is defined in the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana Act, 2018 IL 1 MCL 333.27951 et seq., are prohibited in the Village. A state operating license for such establishment shall not be issued or renewed after the effective date of this Ordinance.

Sec. 2 Effective Date.

The ordinance shall take effect 10 days after the date of the official declaration of the vote for the election at which this ordinance was presented
