

**S.T JOSEPH COUNTY
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOR MICHIGAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
FUNDING FOR EMERGENCY PROGRAM INCOME FUNDING**

ST. JOSEPH COUNTY will conduct a public hearing on June 15, 2021 at 5:00pm in the Commissioner's Room on the third floor of the Historic Courthouse located at 125 West Main Street, Centreville, MI 49032 for the purpose of affording citizens an opportunity to submit comments on the proposed Homeowner Emergency Program funded with Program Income received into the County.

ST. JOSEPH COUNTY proposes to use \$32,200 CDBG funds to provide emergency repairs to homeowners in St. Joseph County whose incomes are at or below 80% of Area Median Income (AMI) for the County per HUD regulations. Zero persons will be displaced as a result of the proposed activities, and all repairs shall be classified as emergency conditions by MEDC/CDBG guidelines.
