St. Joseph County will begin allowing the public to access certain departments within the Historic Courthouse as of Monday, June 15th, 2020.

The Historic Courthouse will be open to the public from 9:00am to 4:00pm. We will ask that face coverings be worn, and all social distancing guidelines be strictly adhered to. Temperatures of visitors will be taken upon entry to the office space. Remotely conducting public business is still encouraged.
